RESOLUTION NO. 25-108 OF THE OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE: Certifying the Omaha Tribe's commitment to participate in the FY25 Joint Venture Long-Term Care (JVLTC) Construction Program.

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska (OTN) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (25 U.S.C. 476 as amended); and,

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the OTN provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and,

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe operates the Carl T. Curtis Health Education Center (CTCHEC), an Indian health care facility pursuant to a Title 1 contract under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (ISDEAA), also known as a P.L. 93-638 contract, with the Indian Health Services (IHS) to provide an array of healthcare services; and,

WHEREAS: The OTN authorizes the Indian Health Service (IHS), Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS), to submit a proposal to provide a new long-term care under the IHS DHHS JVLTC; and,

WHEREAS: The JVLTC proposal is to be submitted by the CTCHEC to the IHS: The OTN will provide a larger facility and lease the facility to the IHS at a "no cost" to the Government for a twenty (20) year period; and,

WHEREAS: The OTN agrees to provide the initial equipment;

WHEREAS: In exchange for the tribal acquisition, the IHS is to provide supplies and staffing for the operation & maintenance of the acquired long-term care for the twenty (20) year lease period; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Omaha Tribal Council through the Carl T Curtis Health Education Center approves and ratifies the submission of the Joint Venture Long-term Care Construction Program application; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The Omaha Tribal Council is authorized to make any necessary amendments or changes to the previously noted JVLTC as deemed appropriate for successful execution of this project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The Omaha Tribal Council authorizes the Chief Executive Officer of the CTCHEC to sign all contractual documents required by the JVLTC on the Tribe's behalf.


