RESOLUTION NO. 25-137 OF THE OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE: *Supplemental Roll # 156*

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is federally recognized Indian Tribe of organized under a constitution and by-laws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article IV, Sec. 1 (g) of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal council; and

WHEREAS: the Omaha Tribe has twelve (12) applicants that meet the requirement of $\frac{1}{4}$ (25%) Omaha Blood,

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and,

WHEREAS: the Supplemental Roll 156 will now start with the Tribal Roll Number 10095, and will end with Tribal Roll Number 10106.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: the Omaha Tribal Council hereby authorizes and declares that the applications for Supplemental Roll 156 are complete and ready for approval by the Omaha Tribal Council as per the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska Constitution and By-laws, Amendment II, Eligible for Enrollment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: the Omaha Tribe authorizes the applications will be entered into the Omaha Tribal Enrollment books with the assigned Tribal Roll Number of 10094 with the last name Baxter and ending with the assigned Tribal Roll Number 10106, with the last name of Smidt. This will be the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska Enrollment Supplemental Roll 156.

- A traditional Sky and Earth hand game will also take place during the event.
- A special election on enrollment eligibility will be held on July 9.
- Laura wants to create a welcome packet for new members, including a signed Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB), a support program directory, and a welcome letter from the Council.
