

OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA
CANNABIS REGULATORY COMMISSION
SCHEDULE OF FEES

Adopted pursuant to the Omaha Tribe Cannabis Regulatory Code and the authority of the Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“Commission”).

All fees listed below are in U.S. dollars (USD).

SECTION 1. GENERAL RULES

1. Non-Refundable Application Fees.

All application fees are non-refundable, regardless of whether a license is granted, denied, or later revoked.

2. License Issuance Fees.

License issuance fees are due upon approval of a license application and before issuance of the license.

3. Annual Renewal Fees.

Annual renewal fees are due on or before the renewal date of each license. Failure to timely pay may result in late fees and/or suspension.

4. Tribal Ownership Requirement (Commercial Licenses).

All commercial cannabis licensees must be at least fifty-one percent (51%) owned, in the aggregate, by enrolled members of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska.

a. Non-Tribal individuals or entities may hold up to forty-nine percent (49%) ownership or profit interest, subject to disclosure and approval by the Commission.

b. The fee schedule in Sections 2 and 3 assumes compliance with this Tribal ownership requirement; there is no additional discount based on ownership, because majority Tribal ownership is mandatory.

5. Integrated Tribal Enterprise Licenses (Vertically Integrated, Tribally Owned).

When the licensee is a vertically integrated enterprise wholly owned by the Omaha Tribe, the Tribe shall not be charged any application, issuance, or renewal fees by the Commission.

- a. Any financial arrangements between the Tribe and private management partners (if any) shall be handled by separate agreements approved by the Tribal Council and are not Commission fees.

6. Adjustments by Commission.

The Commission may periodically review and recommend revised fees to the Tribal Council based on administrative costs, market conditions, and regulatory needs.

SECTION 2. COMMERCIAL LICENSE FEES (TYPE 1 APPLICATION PACKET)

A. Cultivation Licenses

Tier 1 – Small Cultivation (canopy up to 2,500 sq. ft.)

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$750**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$2,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$1,500**

Tier 2 – Medium Cultivation (2,501–10,000 sq. ft.)

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$1,500**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$5,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$3,000**

Tier 3 – Large Cultivation (over 10,000 sq. ft.)

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$3,000**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$10,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$7,500**

B. Processing / Manufacturing Licenses

Non-Solvent / Kitchen-Only Manufacturing

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$1,000**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$5,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$3,000**

Solvent-Based Extraction / Manufacturing

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$2,000**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$10,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$7,500**

C. Testing Laboratory Licenses

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$1,500**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$5,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$3,500**

D. Transport / Distribution Licenses

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$750**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$3,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$2,000**

E. Nursery Licenses

- Application Fee (non-refundable): **\$750**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$3,000**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$2,000**

F. Integrated Tribal Enterprise License (Vertically Integrated, Tribally Owned)

For any vertically integrated cannabis enterprise that is **wholly owned by the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska**:

- Application Fee: **\$0**
- License Issuance Fee: **\$0**
- Annual Renewal Fee: **\$0**

Financial obligations of any private management or operating partners shall be addressed in separate contracts or revenue-sharing agreements approved by the Tribal Council and do not constitute Commission fees.

SECTION 3. MICRO-TRIBAL LICENSE FEES (TYPE 2 APPLICATION PACKET)

Micro-Tribal Licenses are for personal, non-commercial cultivation and possession by enrolled Omaha Tribal Members only.

- Micro-Tribal License Application / Initial Registration: **\$25**
- Micro-Tribal License Annual Renewal: **\$25**

The Commission may, by policy, waive or further reduce Micro-Tribal fees for elders or other defined groups.

SECTION 4. CHANGE, AMENDMENT, AND LATE FEES

1. Ownership Change – Non-Controlling Interest

(Addition or removal of owner(s) where overall control does not change)

- a. Fee: **\$250**

2. Ownership Change – Change of Control

(Any transaction that results in a new controlling owner or majority owner, which must remain at least 51% Tribal-owned)

- a. Fee: **\$1,500**

3. Premises Modification – Minor

(Minor changes such as additional cameras, doors, or minor internal reconfiguration)

- a. Fee: **\$150**

4. Premises Modification – Major

(Expansion of premises, new building, or substantial layout changes)

- a. Fee: **\$750**

5. License Category Amendment

(Adding an additional license category to an existing licensee, e.g., adding processing to an existing cultivator)

- a. Fee: equal to the **Application Fee** for the new license category.

6. Late Renewal Fee

(For renewal fees paid after the due date but within any grace period authorized by the Commission)

- a. Fee: **Twenty percent (20%)** of the applicable annual renewal fee.

7. Replacement of Lost or Damaged License Certificate

- a. Fee: **\$25**

For Micro-Tribal License holders, changes of address, grow location, or contact information shall be processed without additional fee, unless otherwise specified by the Commission.

SECTION 5. PAYMENT TERMS

1. Forms of Payment.

The Commission shall specify acceptable forms of payment (cashier's check, money order, electronic payment, or other secure method). Personal checks may be refused at the Commission's discretion.

2. Timing.

- a. Application fees must accompany the application.
- b. License issuance fees must be paid in full before a license is issued.
- c. Renewal fees must be received on or before the renewal date.

3. Failure to Pay.

Failure to timely pay required fees may result in denial of an application, suspension of a license, revocation of a license, or other enforcement actions authorized by Tribal law.
